SEXUAL ABUSE PREVENTION & TREATMENT (SAPT) PROGRAM

The Sexual Abuse Prevention & Treatment Program is designed to provide community education as well as treatment for children and adolescents who have been sexually abused and/or who have demonstrated mild to moderate inappropriate sexual behavior at home, school or within the community. All clinical services are provided by experienced, licensed mental health professionals.

Client Profile:

Male or Female who May be:

- Between the ages of 5 and 18 with youth being treated according to age, developmental level and the nature of problem.
- Suffering from past trauma related to sexual abuse.
- Adjudicated with a sex offense ***or*** have a documented history of sexually reactive and/or offending behaviors.
- Learning disabled but have an IQ sufficient for comprehension and basic reasoning (e.g., 70).
- Experiencing emotional and behavioral problems.
- Displaying other disruptive and/or self-defeating behaviors.
- From a dysfunctional family or adjudicated as a dependant child.
- Suffering or learning to cope with their own past sexual abuse.
- Experiencing mild substance abuse problems.

Common Treatment Areas: *Offense Process, Relapse Prevention, Arousal Reconditioning, Cognitive Restructuring, Victim Empathy, Value Clarification, Anger/Stress Management, Family Conflict/Problems, Communication & Social Skill Development, Sex Education, Conflict Resolution, Impulse Control, Trauma/Abuse Recovery, Family Support and Parent Education.*
